



GRAMPIANS “Ride to Remember” 2020

The 12th Annual GRAMPIANS “Ride to Remember” will be held in the Grampians, Western Victoria on **Sunday, February 2nd.**

The 194km Ride is a green corridor event and is open to all licensed motorcycle enthusiasts, and will be conducted under police escort to maximize safety and to minimize disruption to other road users.

The Ride will start from the Ararat RSL Carpark (*Queen St*) at **9am sharp** and travel on all sealed roads through the rural countryside within the Ararat Rural City, Pyrenees Shire and Northern Grampians Shire municipalities. The Ride will travel through spectacular countryside and take in the townships of Buangor, Elmhurst (*Morning Tea - 45 minutes*), Stawell then the fringes of the Grampians National Park including Pomonal and Moyston and back to Ararat for a relaxing BBQ in the Alexandra Gardens.

Registration: \$40 for Riders and Pillions and includes a complimentary Barbecue Luncheon Pass, Show-bag with the Commemorative 2020 GRAMPIANS “Ride to Remember” Badge and complimentary bottled water which will be handed out following the event.

Importantly, the 2020 Ride perpetuates the memory of Victoria Police who have lost their lives in the line of duty.
