9.00am: Ride (200kms)

Ararat RSL (Registration Area) Carpark/Queen St, Ararat.

NB: Entry is via High St only.

Destination:

The Ride commences from the Ararat RSL Carpark/Queen St at **9am sharp** and travels on all sealed roads through the rural countryside within the Ararat Rural City, Northern Grampians Shire and Southern Grampians municipalities. The Ride will travel through the townships of Moyston, Pomonal, Halls Gap (*Morning Tea - 45 minutes*) then through the Grampians National Park to Dunkeld and back via Glenthompson, Wickliffe, Willaura, Maroona and onto Ararat for a relaxing lunch in the Alexandra Gardens.

GRAMPIANS "Ride to Remember"

The GRAMPIANS "Ride to Remember" is organised by motorcycle enthusiasts, all recreational riders from the Grampians Region who want make a contribution to their community. They form a Sub Committee of the Victoria Police Blue Ribbon Foundation - Ararat Branch who will ensure a safe and enjoyable ride for all participants.

There are obvious synergies between the Victoria Police Blue Ribbon Foundation, police and motoring. We are grateful for the support of our local experienced motorcycle riders, Victoria Police (Northern Grampians Region), Ararat Rural City, Northern Grampians Shire and Southern Grampians Shire councils who are assisting with the planning of the Ride.

The Traffic Management and Emergency Evacuation Plan for the GRAMPIANS "Ride to Remember" will be under the supervision of the Victoria Police - Northern Grampians Region. This will be a 'green corridor' event under police escort to maximise safety and to minimise disruption to other road users. Because we will be expecting hot conditions at this time of the year, there will morning tea (45 minutes) at Halls Gap so riders can rehydrate and stretch their legs. Depending on conditions on the day a further 'water stop' will be put in place along the Ride route at Glenthompson.

Parking of bikes following the Ride at Alexandra Gardens will be in a designated area.

"SHOW N SHINE"

Watch out for the directional signage in Alexandra Gardens, enter via the first entry gate.

REMINDER

BRING ALONG YOUR ON-LINE RECEIPT

All pre registrations will be required to present their receipt to collect their complimentary Luncheon Ticket at the Registration Area at the Ararat RSL on the morning of the Ride by 8.30am.

*No ticket - No Ararat Lions Club Lunch!

The complimentary 2021 Commemorative Badge and the Showbag will be given out together with your lunch, bottled water at the conclusion of the Ride at the Alexandra Gardens.

REGISTRATION in advance (see Early Registration Special Offer) is preferred via <https://www.trybooking.com/BNGYM> s preferred.

However entries will be accepted on the day of the Ride at the Registration Area, Ararat RSL. Those registering on the day will need to arrive early and make sure they complete registration prior to the start time. The Registration Area will operate from 7.00am.

All participants will be required to provide their personnel details for COVID contact tracing purposes at the Registration Area prior to the Ride commencing.

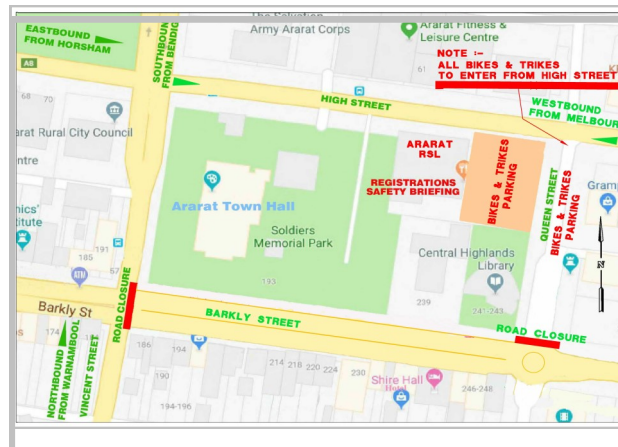
There will be a formal **SAFETY BRIEFING** in the Ararat RSL carpark for Riders/Pillions at 8.30am outlining details of the route and any conditions that may apply to the day.

The Ride is 200kms so ensure you have adequate fuel on board to cover the distance. The only available petrol outlet is at Halls Gap. Bottled water is a good idea to pack for the Ride as weather could be warm. Bottled water will be for sale at the Registration Area prior to Ride departing and also at the Halls Gap morning tea.
